Objectives

- To recognize the outstanding academic achievements of students of Iranian descent attending universities in the DC area and the Eastern United States and their excellent service to the Iranian and Iranian-American Communities.
- To attract the financial support of the large Iranian community in the DC area for high-achieving Iranian students in the US.



Two types of scholarship

- The Dr. Farideh Toorany Memorial Scholarship, which recognizes medical students (a certificate and a monetary award of \$1000)
- Other IAAP Scholarships include a certificate and a monetary award of \$500



Eligibility requirements

- Only students of Iranian descent who were enrolled full-time on the application due date at learning institutions within the states shown in red were eligible to apply.
- Following applications were not considered:
 - Postdoctoral Associates, MD fellows or MD residents,
 - From geographical regions outside the states above,
 - Previous recipients of IAAP scholarships in the same degree program,
 - Part-time students.




Evaluation criteria

 - General


each third of the pie represents 100 points


Applications statistics since 2012


DISTRIBUTION BY DEGREE




